The Board of Commissioners of the City of Maysville, Kentucky met in regular session on Monday, Nov. 2, 2020 at 12:00 p.m. at the Maysville Municipal Building. Present were Commissioner Andrew Wood, Commissioner Jeff Brammer, Commissioner Kelly Ashley, Commissioner Victor McKay, and Mayor Charles T. Cotterill. Also present were City Manager Matt Wallingford, Public Works Director Dennis Truesdell, and Police Chief Jared Muse.


TRANSIT SERVICE

Commissioner McKay asked that transit service be operating on Election Day because people still need to get work. City Manager Wallingford asked whether that is just for election days or all holidays. Commissioner Ashley said most holidays everyone has off, but for Election Day it's just another day. Public Works Director Truesdell said he wasn't sure if he could anyone to work at such short notice and he would need two drivers to cover 12-hour shift. Commissioner Ashley recommended offering them another day off or double time, but he would like to see the full 12-hours operate. Only two drivers with passenger endorsements know the route, Public Works Director Truesdell said. The route cannot be altered. He suggested splitting the shift 3 hours in the morning and 3 hours in the evening for workers, if he couldn't get two drivers.

Mayor Cotterill said it was not acceptable to him. He notified the City Manager on Friday, but the bus drivers had not been notified. The Public Works Director said he had not been able to reach the drivers. The Mayor said it sent the public the wrong message to not have public transportation on a Presidential Election Day. City Manager Wallingford assured the Board of Commissioners that they would work something out.
