Ordinance No. 08C-27**

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 231.12
Summary

This Ordinance adds Code of Ordinances Section 231.12 to add a provision that within three days after any order of revocation of a license becomes final, notice of revocation shall be given to the licensee and to the owner of the licensed premises. The licensee shall at once surrender the license to the City Alcoholic Beverage Control Administrator. If the revoked license is not surrendered by the licensee, the Chief of Police shall cause one of his officers to take physical possession of the license and return it to the City Alcoholic Beverage Control Administrator. Appeals from the decision of the City Alcoholic Beverage Control Administrator shall be to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board. If a license is revoked or suspended by an order of the City Alcoholic Beverage control Administrator, the licensee shall at once suspend all operations authorized under his license.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MAYSVILLE, KENTUCKY, as follows:

(1) Code of Ordinances Section 231.12 is hereby adopted to read in its entirety as follows:

§ 231.12 SURRENDER OF LICENSE

- (A) Within three (3) days after any order of revocation of a license becomes final, notice of revocation shall be given to the licensee and to the owner of the licensed premises. A notice mailed to the licensee and to the owner of the licensed premises at the address shown in the last application for a license or in the last statement supplemental to the application shall be deemed sufficient compliance with this section. The licensee shall at once surrender his license to the City Alcoholic Beverage Control Administrator. If the revoked license is not forthwith surrendered by the licensee, the Chief of Police at the request of the City Alcoholic Beverage Control Administrator shall immediately cause one of its officers to take physical possession of the license and return it to the City Alcoholic Beverage Control Administrator.
- (B) When a license has been revoked, the former licensee may with prior approval of the City Alcoholic Beverage Control Administrator, dispose of and transfer his stock of alcoholic beverages to an appropriate entity.
- (C) Appeal from the decision of the City Alcoholic Beverage Control Administrator shall be to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.

- (D) If a license is revoked or suspended by an order of the City Alcoholic Beverage Control Administrator, the licensee shall at once suspend all operations authorized under his license.
