

Business Inspection Guidelines

BUSINESS INSPECTIONS

The Maysville Fire Department conducts inspections of each business in the city annually. During an inspection we look for unsafe conditions or hazards that may contribute to the start of a fire.

Insuring occupants of the building a safe way to exit during an emergency situation is also part of the inspection process. The department checks all emergency signs and lighting, housekeeping, fire protection equipment, electrical boxes, sprinkler system tests, occupancy loads, egress passageways and much more.

If a violation is found, the owner or occupant will be notified and will be instructed to correct the violation within a period of time not to exceed sixty days. If the fire department is required to make additional inspections, beyond the initial inspection and one follow-up inspection to determine if the required corrections have been made, the fire department shall assess a fee against the property owner to recover the cost of each additional inspection according to the following schedule:

Third inspection fee-----\$100
Fourth inspection fee-----\$200
Fifth and subsequent inspection fees----\$500
