

## **Burn Permit Guidelines**

### **BURN PERMITS**

Anyone wanting to burn in the city must have a burn permit, which is issued by the Maysville Fire Department. The fire department must inspect and approve the site before a permit can be given.

Open burning of the following items is prohibited at all times:

Agriculture:

Animal Bedding, Hay, Muck Piles

Chemical Containers:

Agricultural; Household

Construction:

Asbestos Materials, Buildings, Houses, Barns, Garages, Construction Debris, Demolition Debris, Drywall, Shingles

Wood Materials:

Fence Posts, Painted Wood, Pallets, Sawdust, Treated Wood, Wood Shaving and Chips, Wood Mulch

Miscellaneous:

Coated Wire, Garbage, Insulated Wire, Motor Oil, Plastic, Rubber, Tires, Used Oil, Waste generated by businesses, schools, churches and farms

Some open burning is allowed with restrictions and they are:

Camp fires, Ceremonial Bonfires, Warming at construction sites, cooking, Fire Training, Household Trash (paper products only), leaves, natural growth from land clearing, plant beds, tobacco curing, tree limbs felled by storms, weeds, natural land management, animal carcasses (disease control).
