The Board of Commissioners of the City of Maysville, Kentucky met in regular session on Wednesday, May 20, 2020 at // 9 .m. at the Maysville Municipal Building. Present were Commissioner Andrew Wood, Commissioner Jeff Brammer, Commissioner Kelly Ashley, Commissioner Victor McKay, and Mayor Charles T. Cotterill. Also present were City Manager Matt Wallingford, City Clerk Lisa R. Dunbar, City Attorney Kelly Caudill, Comptroller Penny Stanfield, Fire Chief Kevin Doyle, Project Coordinator David Hord, Utility Manager Darren Garrison, and Main Street Director Caroline Reece.

DISCUSSION: 4TH OF JULY CELEBRATION

Main Street Director Reece reported that Flemingsburg and Vanceburg have both canceled their planned fireworks displays, but Augusta and Ripley, OH had not made a decision yet. She suggested having the fireworks, parade, and other events on Labor Day weekend as many communities are doing. Commissioners Ashley and Brammer agreed that postponing the celebration would be prudent given the issue of social distancing. Commissioner McKay said that Buffalo Trace Health Department Director Allison Adams had told him that she was not as concerned about a fireworks display as she was about the swimming pool. Commissioner Wood said that he thought the public deserved a celebration after weeks of isolation.

Motion by Commissioner Wood, second by Commissioner McKay to hold the fireworks display on the 4th of July. Upon call of roll, voting is as follows: Voting aye: Commissioner Wood, Commissioner Brammer, Commissioner Ashley, Commissioner McKay and Mayor Cotterill, Motion passes.

UPDATE ON RECENT FIRE

Fire Chief Doyle reported security camera footage showed that the fire at Hardymon Lumber had burned for about 40 minutes prior to the fire being called in. That footage revealed that no one had been near the area where the fire started for hours prior to the fire. It was determined that the fire was accidental or a wiring issue. The business owner cleaned up debris quickly and is in the planning process to rebuild.
