
PRESENTATION: BROADBAND SURVEY

Heather Mills and Matt DeHaven from CTC Technology and Energy gave a presentation on the results of a broadband survey of the county and the costs and funding resources available for a broadband improvement project. The survey found that 73% of households participating had speeds lower than the current benchmark of 25/3 Mbps. CTC estimated that the project cost to make broadband available throughout the county at \$65.2 million. They named a number of possible funding sources including the Economic Development Administration's Economic Adjustment Assistance Program, the USDA Rural eConnectivity Program, the Rural Digital Opportunities Fund, the Broadband Equity Access Deployment Program in the new Federal Infrastructure Bill as well as the Kentucky ARPA funding.


No action was taken.
